ITINERARY (subject to change)

Day 1- MAR 27th Board buses to JFK Airport for an afternoon flight to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly aboard a wide cabin jetliner. Cross International Dateline!

Day 2- MAR 28th Arrive early evening at Beijing Airport where you'll be met by your local tour guide. Transfer to the hotel after dinner.

Day 3- MAR 29th Sightseeing: Tian An Men Square, the Temple of Heaven, the Forbidden City. Also the Summer Palace, Kunming Lake, Longevity Hill, Seventeen-Arch Bridge and Marble Boat.

Day 4- MAR 30th Tour bus excursion to the 4,000-mile long and 2,000 year old Great Wall of China. Also visit the Ming Tombs. Roasted Beijing Duck Dinner.

Day 5- MAR 31st Morning flight to Shanghai; bus trip to Suzhou. Sightseeing to Lingering Garden, Tiger Hill and Hanshan Temple. Evening Dinner Show of traditional Chinese music.
