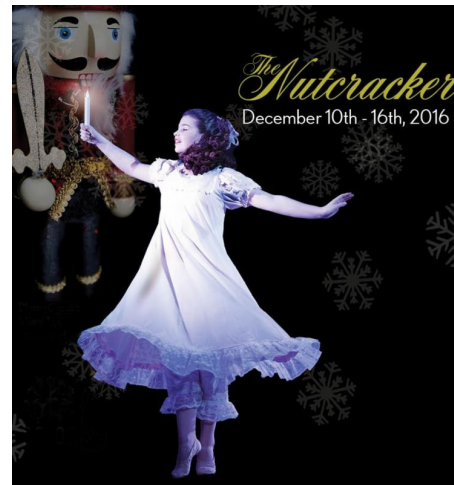
## "The Nutcracker"
